WANT TO GET PAID IN A TIMELY FASHION?

SEPTEMBER MEETING AGENDA:

Referee open discussion with problems, concerns, and questions from the first 2 weekends of play. Senior referee discussion of what they saw out on the fields. Review of the new Mentor Program. Referee Training.

There will be NO DUAL SYSTEM (2 Referees) allowed on ANY GAME. If only 2 referee's arrive at the field by the game start time, then a CLUB LINE will serve as the other position. You need to instruct the Club Line that the only call they will make is if the ball goes over the touch line. Please remind them that the whole ball must cross over the whole touch line before it is out.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM CYSA ABOUT CASTS AND SUPPORTIVE BRACES.

Please read and understand! Page 44 of the 2001/2002 CYSA Constitution, Bylaws, General Procedures...

PIM 00-2 PLAYERS USE OF CASTS AND SUPPORTIVE BRACES

"Players wearing orthopedic casts, braces (metal, carbon fiber, hard plastic, and like devices), or splints (air or metal) shall NOT BE ELIGIBLE to participate in any game, practice, tryout or training session. (Reference Section 3:08:01)"

Referee's: Please understand and enforce this. We will be posting up a laminated copy of this page from the CYSA book in the green storage shed in case a coach needs to see this rule for him/her self.

Referees who want to do games during the week will be responsible for contacting the assignors for those games directly (Tracy {U16 Class 4 Center Only}, Wendy {U-16, AR Only}, Pam {Center & AR U12, Class 4}, Annie {U-14 Centers and AR}, Kristinand Marissa {U-10 Centers Only}), on their own. Games usually start at 5:00 pm.
